- 32 beds are Now Available for volunteers WITH confirmed reservations.

Bring your own twin size linens and pillows.
- Kitchen is available BUT volunteers must buy AND prepare their own food.
Some grocery stores are open in Panama City. Pots and pans are available.
- There is NO CHARGE to stay at Camp Trinity.
- Power is on. Water is on. Cell service is better now.
- NO internet. Bring “hotspot.”
- You are encouraged to prepare your own devotional times.
- Sunday Services are being conducted by Trinity's pastor, Rev. Paul McComack.

- Tree and Debris Removal Ministry:
Chainsaw Operators, Limb Draggers and Skid-Steers especially needed.
 - Chainsaw Operators do NOT have to be LERT Certified but MUST be willing to follow all LERT Safety Rules. (LERT = Lutheran Early Response Teams)
 - Certification is available on-site. Safety equipment available on-site.
- Distribution Center Ministry:
Volunteers needed to help unload trucks, organize, and distribute food / cleaning products, etc.
